- 5. The Committee will consult with all trustees and develop recommendations for consideration at the Board on January 15, 2025.
- 6. The Committee will be dissolved following consideration and approval of Resolutions at the January 15, 2025 Board Meeting.
- 7. Approved resolutions must be submitted to OCSTA by 12:00pm on February 7, 2025, in the required format.
- 8. OCSTA's Resolutions Committee will then determine the value of the resolutions submitted by member boards and provide recommendations for consideration by all members at the AGM, referral to an OCSTA committee, or no further action.
